B. THE LEPER'S REQUEST/_____

And a man with leprosy came to Jesus, imploring Him and kneeling down, and saying to Him, “If You are willing, you can make me clean.”⁴¹Moved with compassion, Jesus reached out with His hand and touched him, and said to him, “I am willing; be cleansed.”⁴²And immediately the leprosy left him, and he was cleansed. (Mark 1:40-42 NASB)

Come now, you who say, “Today or tomorrow we will go into such and such a town and spend a year there and trade and make a profit”—¹⁴yet you do not know what tomorrow will bring. What is your life? For you are a mist that appears for a little time and then vanishes.¹⁵Instead you ought to say, “If the Lord wills, we will live and do this or that.”¹⁶As it is, you boast in your arrogance. All such boasting is evil.” (James 4:13-16 ESV)

Three times I pleaded with the Lord to take it away from me. ⁹But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." (2 Corinthians 12:8-9b NIV)

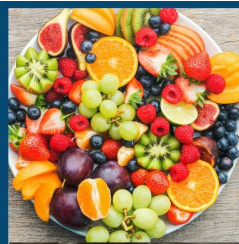

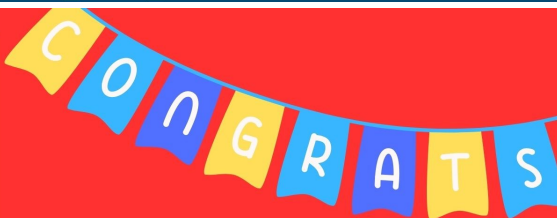
